



Moreton Bay Research Station (MBRS) Environmental Training and Awareness Program

1. Scope

The Training and Awareness Program is to promote the environmental management principles set out in The University of Queensland Moreton Bay Research Station (MBRS) EMS.

2. Objectives

- To communicate the University's environmental policy to all the staff and researchers;
- To raise awareness of staff and researchers' environmental responsibilities; and
- To provide a training and awareness program with respect to environmental management at The University of Queensland MBRS.

3. Environmental Training Activities

Environmental training assists staff and researchers to meet their environmental responsibilities. Items available are:

3.1 *Awareness Sessions*

All staff, researchers and visitors that visit MBRS must attend an awareness session that will include an overview of environmental practices that must be adhered to while on the island.

3.2 *EMS Manual*
