



Level 6 Water Restrictions Fact Sheet – Building, Construction & Development



Building, Construction and Development

Town water is not permitted to be used for building construction purposes except where using:

- a bucket filled directly from a tap
- a high pressure water cleaning unit or
- a hand held hose

The construction site must be attended at all times when water is being used.

Town water is not permitted to be used for activities associated with land development and subdivision (including dust suppression, earthworks, service construction, landscaping, slope stabilisation or erosion control) or roadwork activity.

Tips on saving water

Use recycled water for dust suppression.

Seek alternate water supplies first.

Don't leave hoses unattended on building sites.

NOTE: Building construction means all forms of building construction including the construction of driveways and pathways, concrete masonry and general building activities which is undertaken on a commercial or non-commercial basis and includes painting and the preparation for painting/re-surfacing but does not include garden watering.
