

Level 6 Water Restrictions Fact Sheet - General



General

UQ is required to provide quarterly reports on performance of Water Efficiency Management Plans and consumption and to ensure compliance with water targets.

Town water is not permitted to be used for bathroom, laundry, ablution (hand basins) or kitchen fittings except where:

- All taps are water efficient
- All showerheads are water efficient
- All trigger sprays are efficient
- Urinal systems are water efficient (completion date March 2008)

If you find any inefficient fittings at UQ please contact Property and Facilities Works Control Centre and report it.

Tips on saving water

Reduce your average shower time to 4 minutes and save at least 36 litres of water a day – that's 90 million litres a day across SEQ.

Run only full loads in dishwashers and washing machines and use the economy settings to save at least 4 litres a day.

Don't walk away and leave taps running.
