

Level 6 Water Restrictions Fact Sheet – Vehicle Washing



Vehicle washing water restrictions

- Vehicle mirrors, lights, glass surfaces and number plates must only be washed with a bucket filled directly from a tap. Vehicles can also be spot cleaned to remove paint damaging marks.
- Town water can be used to flush an inboard or outboard motor or the brakes on a vehicle to prevent corrosion and maintain safe operation.
- **Town water is not permitted to be used to wash a vehicle** (including boat or caravan) except where the washing is undertaken by a Mobile Commercial Operator in accordance with the [Vehicle Washing Best Practice Guidelines](#).

Tips on saving water

A number of new products are available for waterless car washing.

Take your vehicle to a licensed car wash facility where the water is recycled.
