Visy Recycling	Glass Most plastics	Provided there is a large amount of material; Visy will send a sales representative to the site to provide a quote. Can supply skip bins to the site	1300 368 479
Veolia	Soil Metals Timber HDPE Cardboard Plasterboard (<i>Must be homogeneous; cannot contain materials such as fiberglass</i>)	Metals are sent to SIMS metals HDPE sent to Visy recycling An extra skip will be provided for plasterboard	3275 0111
SIMS metal management	Most metal from C&D waste	Contact sales rep and provide an overview of project	3277 3000
UQ furniture section	Furniture	Re-used in UQ, auctioned or given away to Government Departments. If not possible, dismantled so that components can be recycled. If none of these are possible – land filled	Contact: Warehouse Supervisor (P&F Services Section) 336 52735
CMA – Eco cycle	Fluorescent light tubes.	All fluorescent lights are recycled by CMA. A skip is located at the Property & Facilities Workshop (Bldg 87).	Contact: P&F Cleaning Manager 336 52177
